Geoscape Data terms – Third Party Terms

1. Overview

These terms (**Terms**) apply if we provide a service to you which includes access to and/or use of Geoscape Data.

2. Terms of Use

- 2.1 In using the Geoscape Data, you must comply with the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) and any recommendations made or guidelines issued by the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner.
- 2.2 You must ensure that any reproduction or expression of Geoscape Open Data and any Derived Material created from it appropriately references the copyright and disclaimer information set out in the Geoscape Copyright Notice and Disclaimer (see www.geoscape.com.au/legal/data-copyright-and-disclaimer). For example:
 - (a) For any reproduction or expression of Geoscape Data, you may use the following disclaimer:

"[insert name of our Geoscape Data Set] © Geoscape Australia [insert year of version of Geoscape Data used] for Copyright and Disclaimer Notice (see www.geoscape.com.au/legal/data-copyright-and-disclaimer)".

(b) For any other Derived Materials, you may use the following disclaimer:

"Incorporates or developed using [insert name of Geoscape Data set] © Geoscape Australia [insert year of version of Geoscape Data used] for Copyright and Disclaimer Notice (see www.geoscape.com.au/legal/data-copyright-and-disclaimer)".

If you require guidance on the names of Geoscape Data sets of years of versions of Geoscape data used to include in your copyright and disclaimer references, please reach out to us.

- 2.3 You must not make Geoscape Open Data or any Derived Material created from it available under an open licence to any other person or permit any other person to make it available under an open licence.
- 2.4 If we grant you a perpetual licence to use Geoscape Open Data or any Derived Material created from it, any such perpetual licence is revocable in the event of a beach of these Terms. If we revoke your licence under this clause, you must permanently delete or destroy any Geoscape Open Data or Derived Material in your possession or control.

3. Definitions

Geoscape Australia means PSMA Australia Ltd (ABN 23 089 912 710) trading as Geoscape Australia.

Geoscape Data means data sets created by Geoscape Australia, including but not limited to the Geocoded-National Address File (GNAF), Administrative Boundaries, and Postcode Boundaries data sets.

Derived Material means any product, service, output or other material that is created or developed by you using Geoscape Data (regardless of whether it contains Geoscape Data), and includes any product, service, output or other material that is created or developed using Derived Material. For example, any output that is created using Geoscape Data is Derived Material, and so is any secondary output that is created from that first output.

Geoscape Open Data means any Geoscape Data subject to an open licence which may be derived from or based on open data, and includes the data described in the Geoscape Data Copyright and Disclaimer as being open data.

We, our, us means the party identified as 'Experian' under the agreement for the Geoscape Data.

You, your means the party we licence the Geoscape Data to under an agreement.
